

## MRC High Power League Rules

1. SR1's (or a provided substitute form by the league) are to be entered for each shooter ONCE for the spring league session and ONCE for the fall session.

No SR1 entry-No posted scores. No exceptions.

Please complete all fields and print legibly.

2. It is the individual shooter's responsibility to verify scores on the day of the match before the score card is totaled and signed by the team captain. It is the team captain's responsibility to add up the highest four scores and place the team score on the card in the designated area before submission. Scorecards not totaled will not count for team awards. Scorecards not signed by the team captain will not count. Scores will not and cannot be changed after the scorecards are submitted for record.

3. A team shooter must participate in both session matches and on the same team for his/her scores to count for receiving a team award (i.e., medals, trophies, etc.).

4. Makeup scores will be allowed if the shooter can be squadded on another team to round out a team. The scores will be transferred from the team scorecard onto a separate score card and marked as "Makeup" with shooter's name and team name.

5. Rain dates are reserved for makeup team matches and cannot be relied upon for individual make up scores. If rain dates are not otherwise used, there must be a minimum of four shooters and a host to hold a makeup match for individual scores.

6. In the event of a weather postponement of a scheduled match, all teams and host club dates will be moved to the scheduled rain date unless otherwise scheduled by the Match Director.

7. Any club who fails to host on their scheduled match day will be disqualified. No scores will count. Scheduled match days include weather postponed dates.

8. All teams must assume duties for pits and scoring for all relays on any given match day unless excused by the match director. Any team failing to perform the duties will be disqualified.

9. Team members must be card carrying members of their competing club for scores to be valid for individual or team scores reporting and awards. Scores reported for non members will be valid for NRA classification reporting only. Non members must be declared on score cards. Any team willfully in violation will be disqualified.
